What happened at Jesus' baptism and why was he baptised? (BELIEVING)

What kinds of promises are made in a Christian baptism and why? (LIVING)

What kinds of promises are made at a Christian wedding and what does this mean for Christians? (LIVING)

How do promises help Christians feel closer to God? (BELIEVING)

What difference do promises make to me? (THINKING)

BELIEVING

Finding out what people of different faiths believe, what their sacred stories mean, and how they understand their religion.

THINKING

Asking big questions, exploring tricky ideas, and connecting what you learn to your own thoughts and life.

LIVING

Looking at how people put their beliefs and values into action in their everyday lives and communities.
