What does the Bible teach about faith? (BELIEVING)

Are words more important than actions? (THINKING)

What difference do words from the Bible make to how Christians live? (LIVING)

How can we express our own ideas about the Bible's Big Story? (BELIEVING)

BELIEVING

Finding out what people of different faiths believe, what their sacred stories mean, and how they understand their religion.

THINKING

Asking big questions, exploring tricky ideas, and connecting what you learn to your own thoughts and life.

LIVING

Looking at how people put their beliefs and values into action in their everyday lives and communities.
